# Proposition 1

- The water bond passed by voters allocates:
  - \$2.7 billion for future water storage projects
  - \$520 million for safe drinking water
  - \$1.495 billion for environmental restoration
  - \$810 million for more effective water management
    - Integrated Regional Water Management \$510M.
    - Stormwater capture \$200M.
    - Water conservation \$100M.
  - \$725 million for water recycling
  - \$900 million for cleaning up and maintaining groundwater,
  - \$395 million for flood management.
